
Some ideas/data

CDTI projects: some examples

WATER ANAEROBIC TREATMENTS (TRATAMIENTOS ANAEROBIOS DE AGUAS)

General objective: to study the anaerobic processes for the treatment of waste-water to substitute the aerobic processes currently used.



The idea is to:

- Optimize energy consumption in water treatment
- Minimize sludge production
- Focus on urban waste-water and waste-water from agro-food industries

Beneficiary.- DAM with U. Valladolid

CDTI projects: some examples



Smart-RSU is a platform that provides predictive information about how full a specific container will be in the near future, within a scope of 7 days, based on historical waste collection data and contextual additional information.



SmartRSU

The challenge of the Project is to reduce the cost of the infrastructure to be deployed, since only a small amount of bins are equipped with sensors as a means of reference data.

These predictions along with applicable regulation are then used to determine which containers need to be emptied or can safely wait to the next day. The system also defines the optimal routes for the collecting trucks to empty all the selected bins, reducing fuel consumption, working hours and pollution.






